If you have an idea for a medical donation that is not on this list, please email Jorge Archila: info@pop-wuj.org to ask whether you should bring it or not. We especially appreciate when donors provide at least a few months' supply of medications, particularly prescription medicines.

Immediate Need:

- Zinc (ideally liquid zinc, but zinc gluconate pills go into suspension well)
- Oral suspension vehicles (Ora-Blend)
- Probiotics for adults, children, and infants
- Augmentin
- Nexium
- Lipitor
- Nasal steroids
- Migraine medications
- Baclofen 10-20 mg
- Tamsulosin 0.4 mg
- Cefdinir
- Honey cough syrups for infants

- Metronidazole, liquid form
- Acetaminophen, liquid form
- TED stockings/compression stockings (small/medium for men and women)
- Adult blood pressure cuffs (manual)
- Thermometers (Celsius) with thermometer covers
- <u>LeadCare II blood test materials</u> for use with our lead detection machine
- Car (yes, really!) 4x4, to transport medical personnel and supplies to remote clinic sites and patients to clinics and hospitals in emergencies

High Need:

- Eye drops (patanol, olopatadine), naphazoline)
- Decongestants (nasal sprays)
- Metformin 500mg, 850mg, and 1,000mg
- Simvastatin
- Allopurinol
- Carbamazepine
- Divalproex Sodium
- Calcium + Vitamin D
- PPIs: Omeprazole (Prilosec), Lansoprazole (Prevacid), etc.
- Nystatin (liquid)
- Cetirizine (liquid)
- Antihistamine eye drops
- Azithromycin
- Albuterol Inhalers
- Acne Cream (Tretinoin, benzoyl peroxide, tazorac, retin-a, etc.)
- Ear wash equipment
- Eczema cream (tacrolimus, pimecrolimus etc.)
- Infant vitamins (liquid with droppers)
- Lice and scabies treatment (Permethrin)
- Eye drops (Tobramycin-Dexamethasone)
- OB equipment: speculums, vaginal swabs, lubricant

- Otic Suspensions
- Penlights
- Tetracycline cream
- Cholesterol/triglycerides meds (Zocor)
- Ear drops (antibiotics, steroids, etc)
- Hemorrhoid preparation
- Muscle Relaxers (Robaxin, Norflex, etc.)
- Oral Rehydration Supplements
- Oral Steroids (Prednisone; Dexamethasone)
- Other non-albuterol inhalers bronchodilators/glucocorticoids
- Pepto Bismol
- Alcohol Swabs
- Psoriasis preparations
- Ophthalmic ointment for infants (erythromycin or polytrim)
- Vitamin E Supplement
- Moisturizing lotion (ideally travel size)
- Sunscreen
- Hypertensive meds: HCTZ, Enalapril, Lisinopril, Losartan, Aspirin 81mg, Amlodipine
- Ranitidine (Zantac)
- Simethicone Pill form
- Batteries (AA & AAA)

Low Need:

- Gabapentin
- Glyburide/Glipizide
- Antifungal creams
- Antiviral (famciclovir) oral and cream
- Ensure/ Fortified formula
- Excedrin
- Hydroxychloroquine sulfate (Plaquenil)
- Metronidazole cream (for Rosacea)
- Stool softeners and laxatives

- Syringes for insulin
- Topical corticosteroids (Hydrocortisone 1% cream)
- Vitamin B complex
- Warfarin
- Vitamins (Adult, Prenatal, Children's)
- Ciprofloxacin, or other PO 3rd generation Cephalosporins

Other Beneficial Supplies:

- Anti-seizure meds (Carbamazepine, Valproic Acid, Keppra - liquid forms)
- Fetal and vascular Doppler
- Media projector
- Portable Ultrasound Machine
- Pap supplies, exam table sheets (cotton), paper gowns
- Suture and minor surgery equipment
- Vaginal preparation (antibiotics, vaginal wash)
